USERs

The most important in RuraisLAB is its users:

- 23 rural women associations
- mainly in ages between 50 and 70 years (30% over 65)
- •Participation of arround 2.300 women that live in a rural environment characterized by:
 - a low demographical density
 - disseminated nuclear family
 - this fact leeds to isolation and dependency situations.
 - •At the same time, all these users have a little technological culture.

RuraisLAB tries to take advantage of the use of ICTs in this environment as a dynamizing element of the relationship between old and young people, letting elderly take part in the society as well as increasing their participation in policies and activities that are intended for this community.



Focus

RuraisLAB LivingLAB is focused not only on generating R&D and Innovation projects, but in becoming a virtual infrastructure based on the knowledge of the whole ecosystem that allows to improve the innovation process and results to pushing forward a process of participation and cocreation of innovative solutions...



Goals achieved, present results (I)

- * e-Inclusion of galician rural women
 - Use of web2.0 by elderly women in rural environments in order to communicate and create a virtual community.
 - Digital literacy and training in using ICTs for older people, focused on creating "technological" habits based on making specific projects centred in real needs of the environment where they live in.



Goals achieved, present results (II)

- * Rural women integration in R&D projects in the following areas:
 - VHOMO project: **Digital content**, semantics and Internet of Services
 - SORE project: Citizen integration in Emergency systems and environment protection
 - SCTI++: elearning platform to improve gender policies from social education point of view, health, wellbeing,...
- •eGovernment: focused on the areas of Health and Social public services, gender instruments and initiatives, new employment instruments, women entrepreneurship at rural.
